NECMETTIN ERBAKAN UNIVERSITY 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION APPLICATION, PREFERENCE, AND PLACEMENT GUIDE

Applications and admissions for international students to a bachelor's degree and associate programs at Necmettin Erbakan University for the 2024-2025 academic year will be conducted in accordance with the "Principles Regarding the Admission of Students from Abroad" prepared by the Council of Higher Education pursuant to Article 45/f of Law No. 2547 and the University's International Student Admission Directive.

1. APPLICANTS:

a) Provided they are in their final year of high school or have graduated, and:

- 1. Foreign nationals, (on the condition that those studying at secondary education (high school) institutions in Türkiye must have registered before the 2022-2023 academic year [except embassy schools, international private education institutions listed in the MOBIS system, and foreign nationals brought to our country within the framework of the project conducted by the Ministry of National Education])
- 2. Those who were Turkish citizens by birth but have lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission to renounce their Turkish citizenship from the Ministry of Interior and those who can document that they hold a Blue Card (provided that those studying at secondary education (high school) institutions in Türkiye must have registered before the 2022-2023 academic year) (Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 states that "(1) A child born to a Turkish mother or father within the unity of marriage, either in Türkiye or abroad, is a Turkish citizen." It is beneficial for candidates applying to quotas from abroad to review the Turkish Citizenship Law.)
- **3.** Those who acquired Turkish citizenship later while being a foreign national / those with dual nationality in this situation (provided that those studying at secondary education (high school) institutions in Türkiye must have registered before the 2022-2023 academic year)
- **4.** Turkish citizens who completed their entire secondary education (high school) abroad except for the TRNC (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) at Turkish schools opened by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC)
- **5.** TRNC nationals who reside in the TRNC and completed their secondary education (high school) in the TRNC and have GCE AL exam results, and those who enrolled in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and have or will have GCE AL exam results

will be accepted,

b) Applicants whose applications will not be accepted:

1. Turkish citizens who completed their secondary education (high school) entirely in Türkiye or the TRNC,

- **2.** TRNC nationals (except those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL results, and those who enrolled in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and have or will have GCE AL exam results),
- 3. Dual nationals whose first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in clause 2 of item (a) (except those who meet the conditions in clause 4 of item (a)),
- **4.** Dual nationals one of whose nationalities is TRNC (except those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL results, and those who enrolled in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and have or will have GCE AL exam results).
- 5. Turkish citizens or dual nationals whose first nationality is Turkish by birth as defined in clause 2 of item (a) who study at schools within embassies in Türkiye and foreign high schools in Türkiye,
- **6.** TRNC nationals and those who have renounced Turkish citizenship/hold a Blue Card and foreign nationals who will register in secondary education institutions in Türkiye starting from the 2022-2023 academic year (except embassy schools, international private education institutions listed in the MOBIS system, and foreign nationals brought to our country within the framework of the project conducted by the Ministry of National Education).

3. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ONLINE APPLICATION:

- **3.1.** Turkish translation of the high school diploma,
- **3.2.** TR-YÖS Result Document, if available,
- **3.3.** Turkish translation of the certificate of enrolment status from their school for students who are in the process of graduating at the time of application,
- **3.4.** An official transcript showing the courses taken, grades, and grade point average during high school, approved by the high school principal. (Applications with documents that

do not have grading and letter intervals or cannot be converted to the 100-point system will not be considered.)

- **3.5.** Blue Card or the document showing permission to renounce Turkish citizenship obtained from the Ministry of Interior for candidates who were Turkish citizens by birth and lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission to renounce Turkish citizenship,
 - **3.6.** A certified population registration document for dual nationals,
 - **3.7.** Passport or identification card,
 - **3.8.** One (1) photograph,
- **3.9.** Entry and exit document showing that Turkish citizens who completed their secondary education (high school) abroad (excluding the TRNC) or dual nationals, one of whose nationalities is Turkish, were in the country where they studied throughout their education. (This document can be obtained from e-Government, police directorates, or our foreign representations.)

4. APPLICATION, EVALUATION, AND PLACEMENT DATES:

- The date of announcement of placement results may vary depending on the application intensity.
- The registration dates and the additional placement calendar will be announced with the placement results.

5. APPLICATION AND PREFERENCE PROCEDURES:

- **5.1**. Applications will be made online.
- **5.2.** Candidates are responsible for registering to the system with their identity information and email addresses and entering their information completely and accurately. Applications of candidates who provide incomplete or incorrect information/documents will not be accepted.
 - **5.3.** Candidates can choose up to twenty (20) programs from the quota table.
- **5.4.** Applications of candidates who are found to have provided any information or documents that are later determined to be false will be cancelled.

6. EVALUATION AND PLACEMENT PROCEDURES:

- **6.1.** Candidates' placement scores are calculated using the following criteria.
- **6.1.1.** The equivalence of TR-YÖS results, graduation certificates from schools affiliated with the Maarif Foundation, or graduation certificates from European countries in the 100-point system
- **6.1.2.** 90% of the diploma scores of candidates who graduated from high schools in Türkiye and Turkish Republics in the 100-point system,
- **6.1.3.** 80% of the diploma scores of candidates who graduated from high schools in Asian countries in the 100-point system,
- **6.1.4.** 70% of the diploma scores of candidates who graduated from high schools in other countries in the 100-point system,
- **6.2.** The placement process is carried out starting from the highest score, considering the candidates' order of preference.
- **6.3.** In case of a tie in the scores of candidates who prefer the same program, preference is given to the candidate who listed the program higher, and if the tie persists, the younger candidate is given priority.
 - **6.4.** Candidates are placed in only one program among their preferences.
- **6.5.** Applications of candidates who are found to have multiple applications will be cancelled.

7. ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS:

- **7.1.1.** Candidates can learn their placement results on the University's website or by logging into the application system.
- **7.1.2.** Candidates who are entitled to enrol can obtain their acceptance letters by logging into the application system after the announcement of the results.

8. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

- **8.1.** Registrations will be carried out by academic units (Faculty/Conservatory/Vocational School) on the announced dates.
- **8.2.** Candidates whose applications are accepted and are entitled to enrol must apply in person for registration. Registration by notary power of attorney is not allowed.
- **8.3.** The documents required for registration will be announced on the University's website along with the results.
